



The Need-to-Know for Hyderabad's Commercial Real Estate

Q1 OFFICE LEASING GREW; GLV STOOD AT 2.6 MSF

Hyderabad's **GLV hit 2.6 MSF** in Q1 2025, an **11% y-o-y increase. Net absorption nearly doubled** to 1.82 MSF from Q1 2024.

MADHAPUR LED RENTAL SURGE



Citywide rentals rose 3% q-o-q and 13% y-o-y, with Madhapur witnessing the sharpest gains, fueled by high demand and tight supply.

RETAIL DEMAND SOARED; SUBURBS
DOMINATED



Q1 2025 leasing hit 0.81 MSF, a 2% q-o-q increase and a near 2x growth y-o-y. Suburban hubs led with 61% share, driven by Kothapet, Nallagandla, and Kompally.

RESIDENTIAL LAUNCHES HELD STEADY;
THE WEST LED SUPPLY



Q1 2025 saw **10,761 launches**, down 3% y-o-y. **The West led the supply**, driven by Nanakramguda, with North and South following, led by Bachupally and Rajendra Nagar.





High-end and luxury homes dominated supply, **holding a 70% share**, concentrated in Nanakramguda, Gandipet, and Rajendra Nagar.
