LOCATED IN A HIGH GROWTH AREA IN NAMPA

In the identified area, the current year population is 160,133. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 108,707. The rate of change since 2010 was 1.47% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 179,759 representing a change of 2.34% annually from 2023 to 2028.

THE BOISE METROPOLITAN AREA

The area consists of five counties in southwestern Idaho, anchored by the cities of Boise and Nampa. It is the state's largest metropolitan area and includes Idaho's three largest cities - Boise, Nampa, and Meridian. Nearly 40 percent of Idaho's total population lives in the area. The metro area is home to 660,465 people (EMSI Estimate 2014) and a workforce of 330,000 within a 45-minute draw of Boise. The metro area is currently the third largest in the Pacific Northwest after Seattle and Portland.


