

SITE PLAN




Property Overview

Winston-Salem is served by Piedmont Triad International Airport (about 25 minutes from the downtown area) and Smith Reynolds Airport (just 10 minutes from downtown). Smith-Reynolds offers corporate hangars, charter service, and repair facilities. Raleigh-Durham International airport is about an hour and a half from downtown Winston-Salem and Charlotte Douglass International is about an hour and 15 minutes.



FedEx Mid-Atlantic Hub

FedEx operates its Mid-Atlantic Sorting hub at the Piedmont Triad International Airport. It is the company's fifth U.S. hub. In addition to the new facility, a third 9,000-foot runway has been constructed at PTIA to accommodate the HUB's operation.
