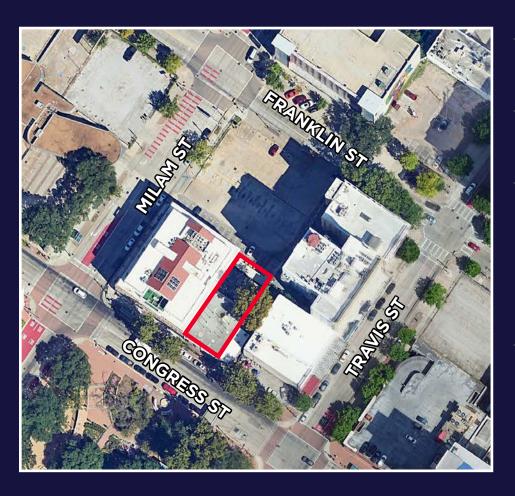

FULL OF HISTORY

Discover the iconic Henke & Pillot building with storied walls from the 1900s.

809 Congress Ave, Houston, TX 77002, the Henke & Pillot building was once home to a prominent Houston-based grocery chain founded in 1872 by Henry Henke. In 1882, Henry Henke hired Camille G. Pillot to manage the company's books. Impressed by his work, Henke made him a partner, and the firm became Henke & Pillot.

Henke purchased the property at Milam and Congress in 1892 and by 1921 had acquired the ½ block with full frontage on Congress Avenue, across from Market Square.

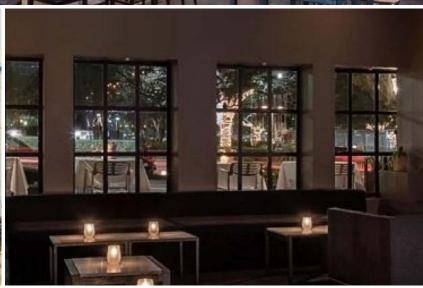
Serving both as a wholesale and retail grocery operation, and in 1921, added a self-serve department. By 1922, the company had over thirty departments, 21 wagons, and 17 trucks, operated by a workforce of 245 employees. Its motto, "The Most of the Best for the Price," helped fuel its expansion. In 1955 the Henke & Pillot was acquired by Kroger and began to resemble the Kroger brand. By 1956, Henke & Pillot operated 27 stores across Houston, Galveston, Pasadena, Velasco, Beaumont, Port Arthur, and Orange, with expansions into Seabrook, South Houston, and Meyerland Plaza. Kroger announced in 1966 that it would be retiring the Henke & Pillot name. Henke & Pillot was notably recognized as the largest distributor of groceries in America.







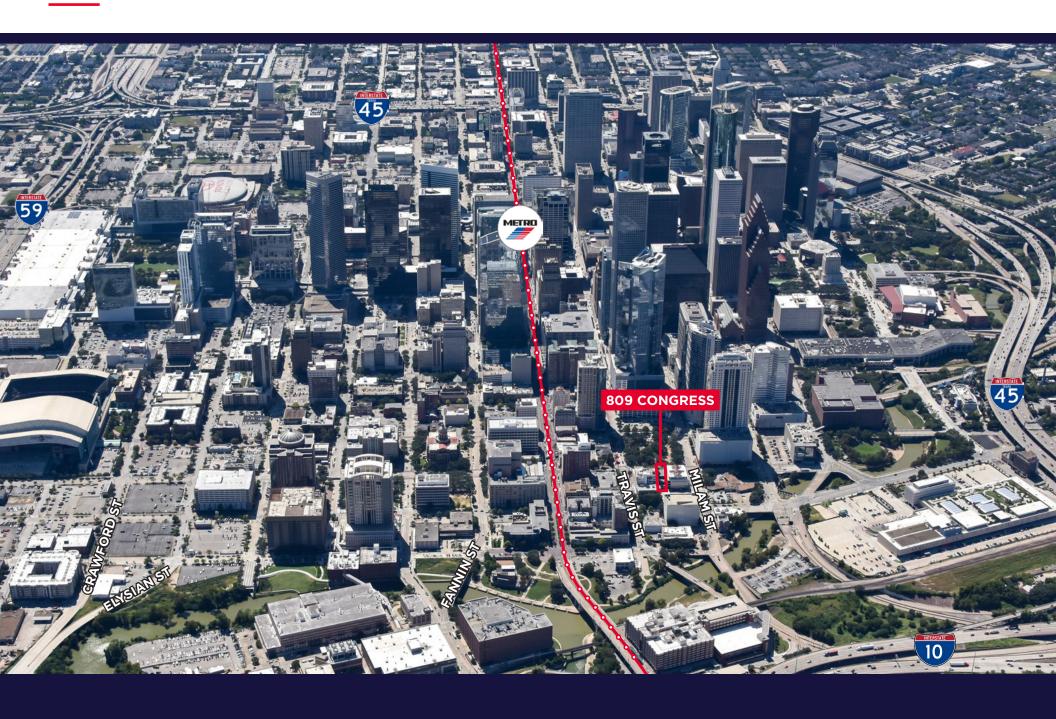


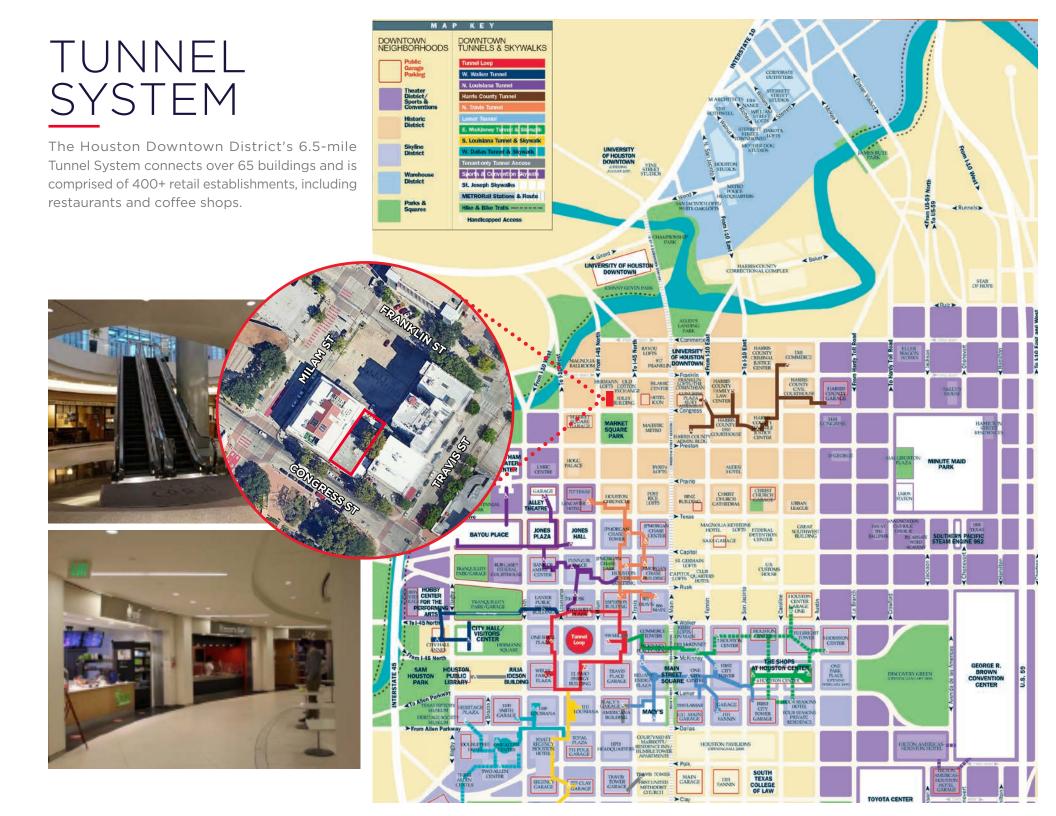

Downtown Houston's skyline features architecturally distinctive buildings that showcase renowned architects such as

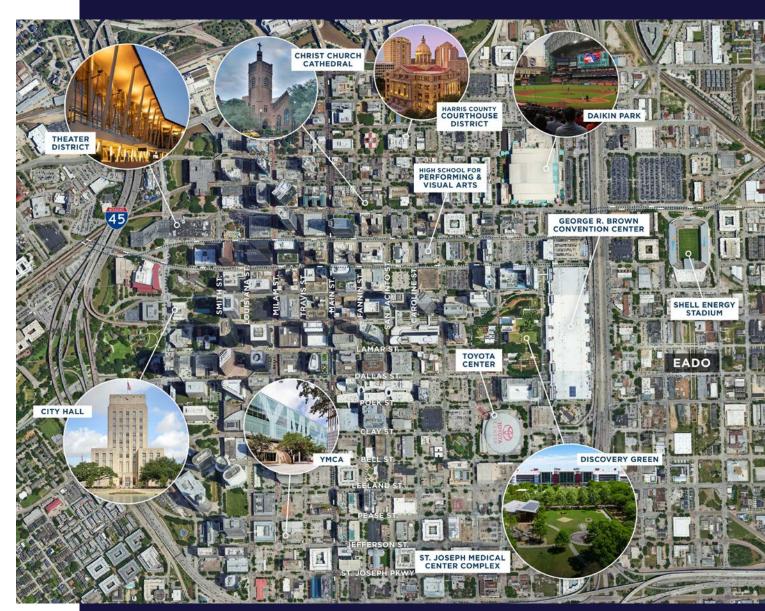

Restaurants & Bars: Downtown offers fast-casual coffee shops and restaurants and food halls to chef-acclaimed dining

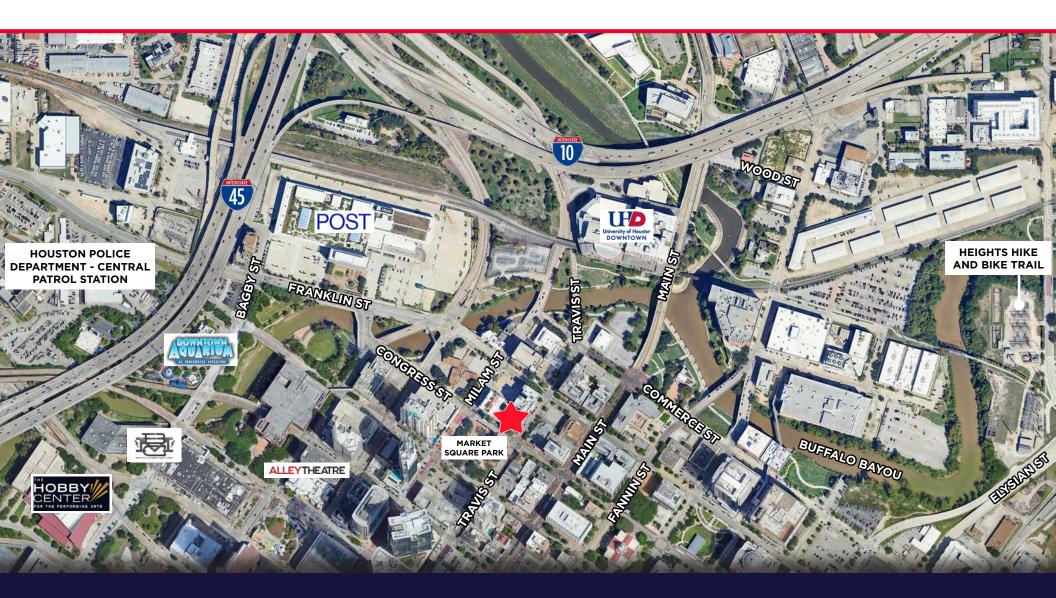
